Mahé Island has so much to offer. From awe inspiring views across the island and beyond, to rare and exotic plant life at Victoria Botanical Gardens and even shopping for Creole crafts and gifts at Domaine de Val des Pres. These gentle giants can live up to 200+ years old and can be found in the Botanical Gardens and on Moyenne Island. ARRIVE



RELAX
